

Directions to Marian Wellman's house
Calle San Luis 88-B
Riberas del Pilar

From Guadalajara, come toward Chapala past the airport.

As you come over the hill and start down toward Chapala, you will see a cutoff road (Libramiento) on your right with a sign pointing to Ajijic. Take that road. Don't go into Chapala.

The Libramiento goes about 3-1/2 miles and ends at a stop light. (A Wal-Mart is right ahead of you at that light, and another shopping center on your left as you get to the light) Take a left at the light, toward Chapala. There will be another light in about ¼ mile. Go through that 2nd light and keep going.

You will go past a golf course on your left (mountain side), a sign for a subdivision Mirasol on your right (lake side). Keep going, and a little further, you will see a 7-11 store (NOT the same as the Oxxo store earlier) on your right. Turn right at that 7-11 store (street name is San Mateo, but not easy to see).

Go one block, and turn left. There is a large orange house on the corner as you turn. This is now my street, Calle San Luis, and I am at the far end of the block you are now on. You will see several houses, then on the right side a parking lot, the beginning of some townhomes painted salmon-colored.

The 1st salmon-colored townhome is 88-D, then 88-C, then a gate opening to the center and the name Coto Palma over the gate, then my townhome, which is 88-B, painted dark red with beige trim. I have a dark green Subaru station wagon with Colorado license plates normally in the driveway. There is also a large cement Olmec head statue on the platform in front of the house, and the door is in the driveway entrance, with a plaque by the door saying "Casa Wellman". Don't be confused by the fact that some recently constructed houses across the street from me were numbered #319 and #320. At the end of this block on the corner is St. Andrew's Anglican church. If you get to the church, you're two houses too far.

Phone number is 765-5273 if you get lost. If calling from a Guadalajara cell phone, you'd have to add "01-376" in front of those numbers.

From Colima or other areas west of Ajijic: Come all the way through town, past the downtown area and through the tree-d housing area of La Floresta, and you will come to the light, with a left turn indication toward Guadalajara, and the new WalMart on the right just ahead of you (which is the Libramiento mentioned above). You will go through this light, keeping to the right side, and then will be at the same spot as the directions show above.
